How does God call us as the Church to live in relationship with one another?

Do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.

Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.*

Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count one another more significant than yourselves.

Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.

Show hospitality to one another without grumbling.

A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another.

A Burden-Bearer is...

(1) Attentive: *are we on the lookout for the burdens of others?*

(2) Prayerful: *do we bring the burdens of others before the Lord?*

(3) Sympathetic: *do we 'weep with those who weep'? do we think: 'you made this mess, you clean it up?'*

(4) Helpful: *do we sacrifice some of our time and resources to get busy burden-bearing?*
