One of our PBA students, **Noah Rusaw**, recently attended a week-long mission trip to Costa Rica. I asked him to write a small update to share with the church regarding what he was doing, its impact on his life, and ways we can pray or get involved in what God is doing in Costa Rica.

"In Jaco, Costa Rica, a team of myself and 12 other college students went and aided the town church "Iglesia Radical". We painted the roof of the church's school (only place of faith based education in the town) and taught Sunday school Bible stories to the kids. So many things impacted myself and my team, such as seeing joy shine through in places of poverty. The mission there is in need of willing teachers and continued financial support for the school."
