We pray that God, by His free generosity, would give us what we need in this world, and that we would enjoy his blessing with them.

What does it mean to pray "forgive our debts, as we forgive our debtors"?

We pray that God, for Christ's sake, would freely pardon all our sins. We are encouraged to ask this by the fact that His grace has enabled us to forgive others freely and from the heart.

What does it mean to pray "lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil"?

We pray that God would either keep us from being tempted to sin, or support and deliver us when we are tempted.
